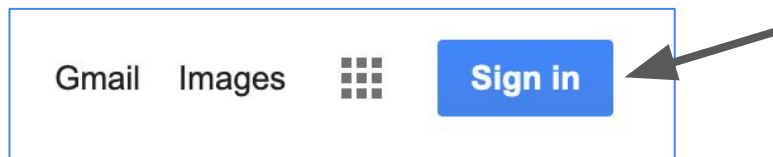


# How to Login to Student Apps at Home

**Step 1: Go to Google.com and click the “Sign in” button. Login with the student @alpinesd.org account.**

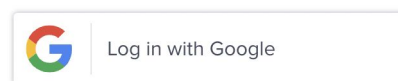
(NOTE: if using a shared device, you may need to “add another account”, switch accounts, or sign out of other accounts)

Using a Chrome browser is strongly recommended



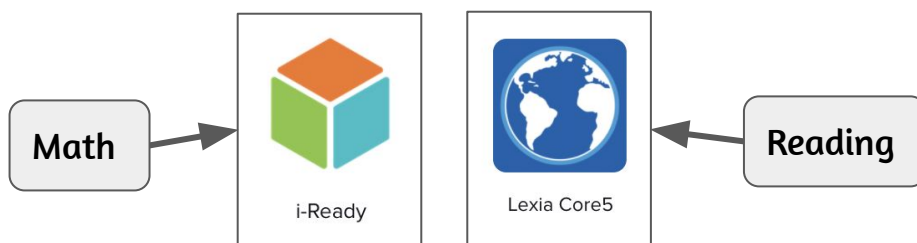
**Step 2: Go to the Clever portal. You will likely want to bookmark this link.**

You will need to click sign in with Google and select your account from the list. The Clever portal is where all of your school supported learning applications are found.



**Step 3: Scroll through the portal and find the application your student needs.**

iReady and Lexia are the most common. Tap on the icon and it will automatically log your student into their account and their personalized learning path.



**Step 4: If you have multiple students sharing a device, when the student is finished with their work, make sure they log out of Clever in the top right corner.**



**Student Account Info:** Every student is assigned a Google username and password. Their username can be found on Skyward. It will look like this: [smithjoh014@alpinedistrict.org](mailto:smithjoh014@alpinedistrict.org)

Students generally choose their own passwords, but K-2 students have a simple passwords created for them. Teachers will share this password with parents.

**HINT:** Usernames follow this pattern

- 1st 5 letters of student last name
- 1st 3 letters of student first name
- a 3 digit number
